In December, the District 34 Board of Education unanimously approved a resolution to place a \$119M referendum on the ballot in the March 2020 election to address facility needs, including infrastructure repairs, building renovations and additions to increase space and allow for full-day kindergarten.

The District 34 community has not approved a referendum since 2000, which secured funds to build Attea Middle School. The community has not passed a district-wide referendum since 1987. Superintendent Dr. Dane Delli will share information about the facility needs and how the referendum, if approved by voters in March 2020, will allow D34 to address them.
